

ACCOUNTING SCHOLARSHIPS

ACCOUNTING ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

Multiple scholarships are made possible by Northwood University Accounting Alumni. **The award is presented to a student majoring in Accounting entering his/her junior or senior year in the year of the award.** Applicants must be U.S. citizens and demonstrate academic excellence, leadership ability, the potential to excel in the field of accounting, and financial need. The members of the faculty in the accounting department select the individual with final approval to be made by the chairperson of the accounting department. Restricted to the **MICHIGAN** campus. (E)

JEFFREY A. BENNETT ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Multiple awards will be made from this scholarship with the amount of the scholarship determined on a case by case basis. Applicants must be studying Accounting on the **MICHIGAN** campus of Northwood University and have obtained a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0. Academic merit and financial need will be a consideration. (E)

WILLIAM R. BRYDEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Three scholarships to be awarded. **First preference will be given to students interested in Automotive Accounting.** Scholarships will be based upon demonstrated financial need and academic merit. Applicants must be U.S. citizens, enrolled in the Accounting curriculum at the **MICHIGAN, FLORIDA** and/or **TEXAS** campus(s) of Northwood University. (E)

RYAN R. HECKMAN/BANK OF AMERICA ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP

Two awards for scholarship will be based upon academic merit and financial need. Applicants must be U.S. citizens, enrolled in the Accounting or Banking & Finance/Management program of study at the **MICHIGAN** campus of Northwood University. The recipient must be a U.S. citizen and indicate his or her intention to enter the certified public accounting profession after graduation. The faculty members of the accounting department select the recipient. Restricted to the **MICHIGAN** campus. (A)

Bob Ellis/Northwood University Endowed Scholarship

Scholarship(s) available to students studying Advertising on the **MICHIGAN** campus of Northwood University. Applicants must be U.S. citizens. Scholarship awards will be based upon demonstrated academic merit, financial need and career interest. (E)
