2009 – 2010 Programs

Northwood University offers a number of study abroad programs for students on its three campuses. Approved programs for the 2009-2010 academic year are listed below. All programs are administered by International Programs in the Office of the Executive Vice President/Chief Academic and Operating Officer.

General Eligibility for Study Abroad programs

Students must:

- Have completed at least 48 term credit hours (sophomore standing). Transfer students must have completed the equivalent of 48 credit hours and one term at NU.
- Be in good academic standing (cum GPA of 2.0 or above).
- Have met course prerequisites for academic credit offered with study abroad programs.
- Read each program thoroughly as each program may have additional and/or more requirements.
- Application, faculty recommendation and course substitution form **are required** for each program.
